| Decision Title                              | Little Addington Neighbourhood Plan Area Designation  |

| Decision                                    | Agreement to designate the Neighbourhood Development Plan Area for Little Addington Parish.   |
| Reason/s for Decision                       | The Localism Act 2011 introduced new powers for community groups to prepare neighbourhood plans for their local areas. The Council has a statutory duty to assist communities in the preparation of Neighbourhood Plans and to take plans through a process of Examination and Referendum, as set out in the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).  Little Addington Parish Council has applied for the designation of the Little Addington Neighbourhood Plan Area. North Northamptonshire Council, guided by Regulations 2012 (as amended), has endorsed this area designation.  In publishing its decision statement, North Northamptonshire Council determined that the qualifying body, Little Addington Parish Council, has made the correct application for the designation of the neighbourhood area and are authorised to act in preparing the Neighbourhood Plan. |
| Alternative options considered and rejected | It is a requirement of the Neighbourhood Planning (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) that the Local Planning Authority determines whether the proposed Neighbourhood Plan Area complies with the Regulations, which it does, therefore no alternative options are required.  |
| Legal implications                          | None. Once the decision statement is published, Little Addington parish Council, as the Qualifying Body, can progress the preparation of the Plan.  |
| Financial implications                      | None direct, the Parish Council can apply for financial support from central Government to undertake its neighbourhood plan. At a later stage in the process North Northamptonshire Council can apply for funds to  |
