

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”)

Notice Issued Under Regulation 10 (General Exception), regarding the Intention to take Key Decisions/Consider an Item in Private without 28 clear-days notice

Regulations 5 and 9 of the above Regulations requires 28 clear days’ notice to be given of all ‘private’ and ‘key decisions’ taken on behalf of the Authority. Where that notice is impracticable, the decision can only be made where:

- the Chair of the relevant Scrutiny Committee has been informed in writing – or, if there is no such person, each member of the relevant Scrutiny Committee by notice in writing, of the matter about which the decision is to be made;
- the Council has issued a Public Notice (i.e. this Notice), setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable; and
- five clear days have elapsed following the issue of the Notice.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 that the Executive intends to make the following key decision, without the 28 clear-days’ notice:

Matter for Decision:	<p>Cannock Road Development</p> <p>Approval to increase the available budget for the Cannock Road development following a full review of the project, updated cost plan (including inflation) and risk register.</p> <p>Delegated authority for the Executive Director of Adults, Communities and Wellbeing, subject to consultation with the Executive Member for Housing, Communities and Levelling Up to take any further decisions/actions to conclude the procurement and deliver the project without the need to return to the Executive.</p>

Reason why impracticable to comply with Regulation 9	Technological failure – the email containing the Forward Plan Submission Form for the item was not received by the intended recipient and the item was unable to be added to the Executive Forward Plan prior to its publication on 17 th August 2022.
