**Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the prevention of crime and disorder:** The premises licence holder will risk assess the need for SIA registered door supervisors at the premises, having regard to any written advice from the police, and deploy such supervisors at such time and in such numbers as deemed necessary by the risk assessment.

Where employed SIA registered door supervisors will be required to wear high visibility garments.

Where employed SIA registered door supervisors will be required to manage the capacity of the venue by using clickers to record patrons entering and leaving the premises

A written drugs policy demonstrating a zero tolerance approach shall be retained and a copy made available for inspection by an authorised officer on demand.

**Describe the steps you intend to take to promote public safety:** A minimum of two members of staff with suitable first aid qualifications will be on duty when the premises is in operation.

The management shall request that no open glass vessels of alcohol are taken by customers outside the premises.

All safety matters at the premises are adequately covered by statutory provisions such as

The Health and Safety at Work (etc) Act 1974 and The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. The applicant is aware of the requirement to produce a written fire risk assessment.

**Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the prevention of public nuisance:**All neighbouring residential, commercial and industrial premises within a ¼ mile radius of the premises will be notified of forthcoming music events 14 days before any such event.

All outdoor regulated entertainment will cease at 00:00.

**Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the protection of children from harm:**Staff shall receive fully documented training on age restricted products as soon as their employment commences and refresher training every 6 months thereafter with written records for each member of staff retained at the premises and made available by an authorised officer on demand.
